Patterned after the successful movie, “The Way” with Martin Sheen, we invite you to a pilgrimage calling on the Holy Spirit to inspire us to be changed as grassroots Catholics. The Camino has existed as a Christian pilgrimage for well over 1,000 years and has many different routes and was named one of UNESCO’s World Heritage Sites in 1993.

On December 8, 2015 Pope Francis named this year a Jubilee Year concluding November 20, 2016. Jubilee Years have a special significance in our Church; they are an ancient tradition generally celebrated every 50 years. They have special spiritual significance and the one we are embarking upon is no different.

All pilgrimages are invitations from God and fully dependent upon the pilgrim’s acceptance. Pilgrimage experiences are personally and spiritually transformational and those open to the experience and flexible within the journey are those who generally reap the greatest benefits.

Pope Francis invites all Catholics to deeper relationships by *encountering* one another by *journeying* together, *hearing* life stories, engaging in *dialogue* understanding “the other” in new ways. He calls us especially to be more merciful as Christians in facing the violent world we live in.

The journey begins in Madrid and ends at the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela.
